1. SUBMISSION OF TENDER :

Polypropylene (PP) Bags Manufacturers having valid manufacturing licence are qualified to participate in the tender. Distributors / Dealers / Agents etc. are not eligible to participate. Supplies shall also be effected directly by the manufacturers and not through Distributors / Dealers / Agents.

Sealed tender should be submitted in two parts (Part-I containing EMD, technical & commercial offer and Part-II containing price offer) in separate sealed covers superscribed as Part-I & Part-II to the Tamil Nadu Coop. Sugar Federation in the above address in person or by post.

The Part I tender should accompany the following documents :

- (a) A Demand Draft No: dated: for Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten lakhs only) drawn in favour of Tamil Nadu Coop. Sugar Federation drawn on any Nationalised Bank payable at Chennai towards the Earnest Money Deposit. The cover containing EMD should be super scribed as EMD in the cover.
- (b) Tender conditions in original duly signed in each page affixing seal of the Company agreeing to abide by the various terms and conditions of the tender.

The Part II tender should contain only price offer in the prescribed format and should not contain any commercial conditions. Variation in the commercial terms and conditions of the tender will not be accepted.

The outer envelope should be superscribed as "**TENDER FOR SUPPLY OF Polypropylene (PP) Bags for 2012-13 season due on 06.03.2013 at 03.00 PM**" Likewise Part-I and Part II covers should also be superscribed as **TENDER FOR SUPPLY OF Polypropylene (PP) Bags - TECHNICAL AND COMMERCIAL OFFER (Part-I tender) for 2012-13 season** " and **TENDER FOR SUPPLY OF Polypropylene (PP) Bags - PRICE OFFER (Part-II) for 2012-13 season** " respectively. Tender received after the specified date and time will not be accepted and taken up for consideration.

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2 OPENING OF TENDER :

Sealed Tenders Part I " Specification and Commercial Offer " **received upto 03.00 PM on 06.03.2013** will be **opened** by the Tender Accepting Authority at the office of Tamil Nadu Cooperative Sugar Federation at **03.30 P.M** on the same day in the presence of the available tenderers or their authorised representatives. Part II offer of only those organizations which satisfy the standard criteria laid down by the Tamil Nadu coop Sugar Federation on the basis of the details furnished by the tenderers in Part-I tender will be opened.

3 OTHER CONDITIONS :

- (a) The person or persons signing the tender shall state the capacity in which he / she / they / are signing the tender. If an individual makes any tender, shall be signed with his full name and address. If it is made by a Firm, it shall be signed by all the partners of the Firm or by a partner of a Firm duly empowered or authorized to do so and the authorization / Power of Attorney should also be enclosed.
- (b) If any tender is made by a Corporation / Company / Coop Society, it shall be signed by a duly authorized officer, who shall produce with his tender satisfactory evidence of its corporate existence before the contract is executed.
- (c) Either the tenderer or the person duly authorized by the tenderer alone will be allowed to be present at the time of opening the tenders / negotiation.
- (d) The Tender Accepting Authority will open each tender and prepare a statement. If any unattested corrections are found in the tender, the same will be handed over to the tenderer concerned and his initial or the initial of the authorized representative got on all such corrections in the presence of the tenderers. If any of the tenderer or their agents find it inconvenient to be present at the time, then in such case, the Tender Accepting Authority will on opening the tender of the absentee tenderer, make out a statement of the unattested corrections and communicate to him. The absentee tenderer shall accept the statement of corrections without any question whatsoever.
- (e) In the price bid all the amounts given in figures and words shall be the same. without any corrections. In cases of discrepancy between the prices quoted in words and in figures, lower of the two shall be considered.
- (f) Tenders specifying additional conditions or proposing modifications to the tender conditions will be treated as conditional offer and will be summarily rejected.

4 VALIDITY OF OFFER :

Tenderers should keep their offer valid for acceptance upto **31.05.2013**. Tenders containing any other validity date prior to **31.05.2013** are liable to be summarily rejected.

5 i) ELIGIBILITY OF TENDER:

The tender will be evaluated based on the following factors in addition to the price criteria.

- (a) The tenderer should have the experience of supplying Polypropylene (PP) Bags to sugar mills/Government/ Public Sector undertakings / Co-operatives or reputed organisations in any one Accounting year during the years 2009-10, 2010-11 & 2011-12.
- (b) The average Annual turnover of the last three Accounting years viz. 2009-10, 2010-11 & 2011-12 should be above Rs.15 Crores.
- (c) The Production capacity should be a minimum of 75,00,000 Nos. of Polypropylene (PP) Bags per annum.
- (d) Performance / Quality certificate should be obtained for supply of Polypropylene (PP) Bags from any sugar mills / Government / Public sector undertakings / Co-operative or reputed organization after 01.04.09.
- (e) The tenders which do not satisfy the above eligibility criteria will be rejected.

ii) EVALUATION OF TENDERS

- 1 The evaluation of price tender shall include all central duties such as customs duty and central excise duty and sales tax as a part of the price as detailed below.
 - (a) In evaluation of the price of an imported item, the price will be determined inclusive of the customs duty.
 - (b) In evaluation of the price of articles which are subject to excise duty, the price will be determined inclusive of such excise duty.
 - (c) In a tender where all the tenderers are from within the State of Tamil Nadu, or where all the tenderers are from outside the State of Tamil Nadu, the sales tax shall be included for the evaluation of the price; and

(d) In a tender where the tenderers are both from the State of Tamil Nadu as well as from outside the State of Tamil Nadu, the sales Tax under the TNGST Act, 1959 shall be excluded for the evaluation of the price"

- 2 Price preference of fifteen percent for domestic small scale industrial unit and ten percent for the Public Sector Undertakings of the Govt. of Tamil Nadu in respect of products and quantities manufactured by them will be given.

6 EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT :

All tenderers should furnish E M D for a sum of Rs. 10.00 lakhs (Rupees Ten Lakhs only) by way of Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque in favour of Tamil Nadu Cooperative Sugar Federation Limited, on any Nationalised Bank payable at Chennai along with the tender. Any amount due to the tenderer from the Federation or from the mills will not be taken into account as EMD for this tender even if so requested by the tenderer.

Tenders without the EMD in any one of the above form will be summarily rejected provided that any category of tenderers specifically exempted by the Government from the payment of EMD are not required to make such a deposit subject to the production of documentary evidence. In the case of SSI units claiming exemption for payment of EMD, an undertaking in a stamped paper valued at Rs.20/- should be furnished for making good the loss, if any, sustained by the sugar mill for breach of conditions warranting the forfeiture of EMD. (Model copy of undertaking enclosed)

In the case of successful tenderers, the Earnest money Deposit remitted by them will be refunded only after satisfactory completion of the supply of the entire ordered quantity and replacement of rejected Polypropylene (PP) Bags and shortages to all the sugar mills. In case of unsuccessful tenderers, the Earnest Money Deposit will be refunded within one month from the date of finalising the tender. The EMD carries no interest. The amount remitted towards EMD is liable to be forfeited, in case, the tenderer resiles from their offer after submission of the tender or after the acceptance of the offer by the Tamil Nadu Coop Sugar Federation.

7. SECURITY DEPOSIT :

The successful tenderer should remit a security deposit of 5% of the total value of the order subject to a maximum of Rs.30.00 lakhs (Rupees thirty lakhs only) by way of Demand Draft / Banker's Cheque drawn on Nationalised Bank in favour of Tamil Nadu Cooperative Sugar Federation Ltd. within 7 days from the date of receipt of the first communication of acceptance of tender from the Tamil Nadu Cooperative Sugar Federation. Only after receipt of Security Deposit, orders for fixation of rate contract will be issued by the Tamil Nadu Coop Sugar Federation Ltd. Any failure to remit the security deposit will entail termination of the contract besides forfeiture of EMD. In addition, the Tamil Nadu Coop Sugar Fedn Ltd will

be entitled to recover the consequential loss if any sustained by the Tamil Nadu Coop Sugar Fedn Ltd from the tenderers due to purchase made in tender or in any other manner. The Security Deposit will be refunded only after satisfactory completion of the supply of the entire ordered quantity and replacement of rejected Polypropylene (PP) Bags or shortage to all the mills. The security deposit carries no interest.

8 BRANDING AND PACKAGING :

The bags are to be printed as per printing matter given by the concerned mills and should be FLAT PACKED in wrapper Polypropylene sheet, well pressed, bound bale containing Polypropylene (PP) Bags duly marked as per BIS specifications and despatched in covered vehicles. Despatch shall be made strictly on "freight paid" basis only at the seller's risk. The Polypropylene (PP) Bags shall be so made that the contents are protected from stains, oil, water or any other damage in handling. Bags should not stick with one another and should easily be separable. The packing must conform strictly to BIS specification.

9 SPECIFICATION

The tenderer should supply Polypropylene 50 Kgs. bags having **inside length: 90 cm. & inside width: 61 cm** and confirming to all other specifications as prescribed by **BIS (IS:14968:2001) and subsequent amendments made there on.** Tenderer should ensure the supply of quality Polypropylene (PP) Bags. For the purpose, a specific undertaking should be given by the successful bidder. The Polypropylene (PP) Bags are to be sent for testing from each consignment and payment is to be made only for the Polypropylene (PP) Bags received as per the specification given above. If the quality is not up to the specified standard, the supplier has to take back the entire load of rejected bags within 7 days from the mills premises. The test charges for sample Polypropylene (PP) Bags sent for analysis will be recovered from the supplier. The Polypropylene (PP) Bags which conform to the above specification alone will be accepted. In case, if Polypropylene (PP) Bags supplied are found not conforming to the above specification, the same will be rejected by the mills and notice will be sent to the successful tenderer by the Sugar Mill requiring them to supply Polypropylene (PP) Bags as per the specification. Even after giving two such notices, if the supplier fails to supply Polypropylene (PP) Bags which conform to specification given above, action will be taken to blacklist the supplier and to disqualify the tenderer from taking part in the future tenders floated by the Tamil Nadu Coop. Sugar Federation. and / mill reserves the right to cancel the order for the quantity of Polypropylene (PP) Bags remaining to be supplied and procure the same at the prevailing market rate from other sources at the risk and cost of the supplier. In that event the loss sustained, if any, by the sugar mills will be recovered from the supplier. The test report of the laboratory with regard to the conformity of the specification criteria is final and the tenderer should accept the same without raising any dispute.

Apart from the above test report the mill shall also undertake 100% checking of the entire Polypropylene (PP) Bags at the time of segregation of the Polypropylene (PP) Bags. Based on the segregation report the mill shall deduct the cost of the defective bags and shortage bags from the balance 5% or subsequent payment. (Please refer payment condition at clause No. 16)

10 SOURCE OF SUPPLY :

Supply shall be effected only from the Polypropylene (PP) Bags manufacturers. The manufacturers shall be responsible for quality and timely supply of Polypropylene (PP) Bags to the sugar mills concerned. Polypropylene (PP) Bags manufactured in India alone should be supplied.

11 PRE INSPECTION :

Concerned sugar mills or Tamil Nadu Cooperative Sugar Federation have the right to pre-inspect the materials either by their Officers or thro' any authorised inspection agency to ensure that the Polypropylene (PP) Bags manufactured are in conformity with the specification given above. The supplier should offer all facilities for inspection prior to despatch. However, the supplier can not be absolved of their responsibility for quality supply just because of the prior inspection. Only final inspection at site of the concerned sugar mills will be binding on both the parties.

12 TRANSIT INSURANCE :

The Polypropylene (PP) Bags despatched should be covered under Transit Insurance upto the delivery at the godown of the Sugar mills concerned. The Tamil Nadu Cooperative Sugar Federation / Sugar Mills will not be responsible for any loss or damages during transit. It is the sole responsibility of the supplier to prefer claims with the Insurance Company for settlement of cost of loss / damages if any. The purchaser shall recover the amount on account of damages / shortage from any pending dues, EMD and Security Deposit of the supplier.

13 QUANTITY AND DELIVERY :

- a) The quantity mentioned in the tender for each mill is only approximate and the concerned sugar mills will place firm order for Polypropylene (PP) Bags for each month requirement 30 days in advance. The supplier is to ensure the delivery of the Polypropylene (PP) Bags within 15 days from the date of receipt of the purchase order. The sugar mills/Federation reserves the right to modify the delivery schedule which is binding on the supplier.
- b) The quantity required is **approximately 60 lakhs pieces** of Polypropylene (PP) Bags. The respective sugar mills will place orders for the exact quantity required. The Tamil Nadu Coop. Sugar Federation and the concerned mills hereby reserves the right and shall be at liberty to reduce or increase the quantity of bags to be supplied during the period of contract remaining in force.

14 DESPATCH DETAILS :

The supplier should furnish the details of despatches made at their end to the respective mill by fax / telegram under copy to Tamil Nadu Cooperative Sugar Federation.

15 PRICE :

The tenderer shall quote FIXED PRICE for Polypropylene (PP) Bags which is common to all tenderers. The tenderers should quote the rates for the following items for Polypropylene (PP) Bags strictly in the format prescribed.

1. Basic Price
2. Excise Duty
3. VAT/CST
4. Packing / Forwarding
5. Transport charges for delivery at millsite
6. Insurance
7. Other Charges, if any

Percentage of ED/VAT/CST and other levies should be quoted separately.

Variation if any, in the Government levies between the date of tender and scheduled date of delivery shall be settled between the purchaser and seller subject to the production of documentary proof.

16 PAYMENT :

95% payment against the valid invoices will be made by the sugar mills concerned within 15 days of receipt of the goods at mill site, based on the Lab test report for each load which conforms to BIS. Specifications as above. The balance 5% payment will be made by the sugar mills within 30 days of completion of supply of the ordered quantity as per the terms and conditions of the tender. Payment will be made by means of A/c payee cheque. If the supplier insists for Demand draft, the bank commission will be borne by the supplier. If the quality is found inferior the sugar mill reserves the right to reject and payment will not be made.

17 CENTRAL EXCISE DOCUMENT :

The supplier shall submit attested xerox copies of the certificate of Registration with Central excise department for CENVAT claim. The supplier shall also submit the Central Excise invoice to the mills and other connected documents for claiming CENVAT benefit when excise duty is levied. The tenderer should give an undertaking in the format in Annexure-V to sugar mills to reimburse demand of additional levy of excise duty or state tax etc., at the time of assessment of sugar mills by respective authority.

18 LIQUIDATED DAMAGE AND PENALTY :

- i. If the supplier fails to deliver the consignment to the sugar mills as per clause 13 above, liquidated damages at the rate of 2.5% of the value of delayed supplies per completed week subject to a ceiling of 10% will be recovered from the supplier. This will be deducted from the bills while making 95% payment.
- ii. If the delay extends beyond 2 weeks, the purchaser shall have the option to cancel the defaulted quantity and to procure the same quantity from other sources at the risk and cost of the supplier, in order to run the sugar mills un-interruptedly. In that event, the supplier is liable to pay to the purchaser, the differential cost including all components and other expenses that would be incurred by the purchaser in respect of this transaction.

19 FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE :

In case the purchaser is not in a position to accept supplies as per terms of delivery due to any one of the following reasons, the purchaser reserves the right to suspend normal supply until the position returns to normalcy or even to terminate the contract if the circumstances are beyond their control.

- i) Strike
- ii) Lock-out
- iii) Accumulation of stocks or non availability of storage space
- iv) Power cut
- v) Decline in production or any other forces or natural calamities which affect the production of the purchaser.

The supplier should supply Polypropylene (PP) Bags without any delay except due to natural calamities. The supplier has to built up the required stock of Polypropylene (PP) Bags and ensure to supply the entire seasons requirements irrespective of strike, lock-out and other reasons except natural calamities.

In the event of delay lasting over fifteen days, the Federation reserves the right to cancel the order / contract without any compensation whatsoever and / or any consequential loss etc.

20 FORFEITURE OF EMD / SECURITY DEPOSIT :

In the event of failure to supply the ordered quantity of Polypropylene (PP) Bags as per the specification or for violation of terms and conditions of the tender, the EMD and Security Deposit remitted by the tenderer will be forfeited. In addition to this, the Tamil Nadu coop Sugar Federation reserves the right to disqualify the tenderer to participate in future tenders or blacklist the tenderer. The Tamil Nadu Coop Sugar Fedn Ltd also reserves the right to purchase the undelivered quantity through re-tender at the risk and cost of the successful tenderers apart from collecting the consequential loss or by adjusting the loss from the bills payable to the supplier.

21 REPLACEMENT AND REMOVAL OF REJECTED BAGS :

The Polypropylene (PP) Bags received that are not in conformity with the specifications as per clause no.9 of terms and conditions will be rejected by the purchaser. The purchaser will open the bales and report the details of rejections if any to the supplier strictly within 60 days from the date of receipt of such consignment at mill site. The rejected Polypropylene (PP) Bags as reported by the sugar mills should be replaced by the supplier in the form of Polypropylene (PP) Bags with the requisite specification within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of intimation from the sugar mills, failing which penalty will be levied as per clause 18 of the terms and conditions. In the case of replacement of defective / damaged Polypropylene (PP) Bags by the supplier at later date beyond 30 days, the value of defective Polypropylene (PP) Bags will be adjusted by the sugar mills at the rate applicable for the original supply or the rate applicable for the month in which it is replaced whichever is advantageous to the sugar mills.

If the cost of defective / damaged Polypropylene (PP) Bags exceeds the 5% retention amount, the difference will be recovered from the suppliers' next bill itself.

If the supplier continues to supply defective Polypropylene (PP) Bags, the purchaser has the right to cancel the remaining portion of the order quantity and procure the same from outside at the then prevailing market rate. In that event, the loss sustained, if any, by the purchaser will be recovered from the supplier.

In case of any dispute as to whether a Polypropylene (PP) Bags is defective / damaged or not the decision of the respective sugar mills shall be final. Rejected Polypropylene (PP) Bags should be removed by the supplier from the sugar mills concerned within 30 days from the date of rejection after replacement.

In the event of non removal of defective / damaged bags, the mills have liberty to dispose of such goods in such manner as they deem fit. The sale proceeds will be credited to the account of the supplier after deducting the expenses incurred for disposal and replacement. The supplier will not be entitled to claim any loss / damage occurred by such sale. The decision of the sugar mill shall be final and binding in all such cases. In case, the purchaser is unable to dispose of rejected Polypropylene (PP) Bags of the supplier, the supplier is bound to pay godown charges to the purchaser until the goods are removed.

If any amount is left unrecovered after the above adjustment, the same will be recovered from pending dues, EMD and Security Deposit of the supplier.

22 AGREEMENT :

The contract will be on rate contract basis and the firm order will be placed by the individual mill based on the rate finalised by the Tamil Nadu Co-operative Sugar Federation.

The supplier should execute an agreement with the individual mill for fulfilment of the contract in non judicial adhesive stamp paper of value as per the law in the prescribed form within 10 days from the date of receipt of purchase orders from the mills. In the event of failure to execute the agreement within the time prescribed, the EMD and Security Deposit amount remitted by the tenderer shall be forfeited. Further, the Tamil Nadu Coop Sugar Fedn Ltd reserves the right to collect the consequential loss, if any, sustained by the member mills from the tenderer and the tenderer is bound to pay the same on demand.

23 JURISDICTION OF COURT :

For any dispute arising out of this contract, the jurisdiction will lie with the court in whose territory the mill is located.

24. APPLICABILITY OF TAMIL NADU TRANSPARENCY IN TENDERS ACT & -RULES

The Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998 and the Rules made thereunder for the time being in force shall apply to the tender.
